## Instructor/Assistant Corner:

Never underestimate the power of foundation skills. It is easy to over look those very first skills we all learn or to put them aside and forget about them. Targeting is a perfect example.

In Beginner class we teach a foot target when we teach the Go To Mat/ Target. It is easy to teach the Go To Mat and never do anything else with foot targets. How many ways can you use foot targeting? It can be used to teach jumps with a target on each side of the jump. I have used them to teach the back up 10' for Advanced Tricks, the Go Out for Utility, the high five and shake hands. It can be used to teach advanced level tricks like pushing an object, crossing one paw over the other, limping or even that cute trick where a dog walks his back feet up a wall.



But foot targets are not the only targets to teach. Teach the dog to nose target your hand or presented objects. I have used this one to teach pushing a ball, indicating the "hot" object in Nosework. You can even teach a sustained nose or chin targeting behavior and use it to teach heeling. Be creative and use it to teach the dog perfect Heel or Front position by coming all the way until he touches the target.

Targets are useful throughout the dog's life so keep that Foundation Skill fresh by continuing to practice targeting so you will have it ready in your toolbox when you need it. Think claw clipping or cleaning muddy feet. It is so nice to have a dog that just offers you the foot! I even know of a trainer who named the feel individually 1, 2, 3, and 4 so the dog offers the desired foot! How cool is that?




