# (Proposed) DTCDC MEMBERSHIP PROCEDURES

To become an active member of the DTCDC, an applicant must complete 12 weeks of training at the DTCDC and must have enrolled in the Novice Polish class, which is a 6-week course. This time frame will enable the applicant to become familiar with the DTCDC training philosophy and methods and provide DTCDC members an opportunity to become acquainted with the applicant.

Applicants who have taken beginning training elsewhere are required to attend 12 weeks in a DTCDC Novice, Open, or Utility class before becoming eligible to apply for Club membership.

Upon completion of the above attendance requirements, the applicant fills out a membership application and gives it to a member of the Membership Committee. The application will be read at the next DTCDC Board meeting by a member of the Membership Committee. If the Board has already met for that month, the application may be presented by polling the Board at any time before the ensuing Club meeting. A copy of the pending application is given to the PawPrint editor for publication, if possible, in the next newsletter.

The applicant is invited to attend the next Club meeting at which a Membership Committee member will introduce the applicant to the Club members. At the following Club meeting, which the applicant does not attend, the membership votes on the applicant.

Upon approval of the application, a member of the Membership Committee gives the new member (1) the Club letter welcoming them, (2) a Club roster, and (3) a membership packet which contains the Club by-laws and committee descriptions. A copy of the approved application (with a notation as to the date applicant was introduced and the date applicant was accepted) should also be furnished to the Club's secretary, treasurer, and PawPrint editor.

The new member should be instructed to mail or give Club dues to the Club treasurer. New members voted on in July or after will have their dues prorated according to the by-laws.

Former Club members who would like to reinstate their membership may do so by (1) filling out an application (noting "REINSTATEMENT" at the top thereof) and (2) attending the next Club meeting where a member of the Membership Committee will introduce them and inform the Club of their reinstatement.

Applicants for Special Activities Associate must complete the appropriate application form and give it to the appropriate committee chairperson, who will then present it to the Membership Committee for consideration.
