The group reviewed and discussed the following:

#### A. The membership application form.

The current types of membership, as set forth in the by-laws, and the purpose of each type of membership were discussed. An amended application form was presented for the group's review and is attached hereto. The proposed form is a combination of the current application form and the biographical information form and would eliminate the need for a separate biographical form.

The Membership Committee recommends adoption of the revised membership application form and the discontinuance of the biographical form.

#### B. Special Activities Associate Membership.

The group reviewed why the Special Activities Associate ("SAA") membership was established and whether there is a need to continue it in view of haphazard procedures which are in non-compliance with current by-laws and procedures (including the acceptance of incorrect fees and non-collection of other fees).

As a result of this meeting, the Membership Committee recommends that the Special Activities Associate membership be cancelled, effective immediately.

The Membership Committee also recommends that the two current SAA members be offered active club memberships and that the obedience class training requirement be waived only in their case. The Committee recommends that the offer remain open for a period of 30 days after notice is given to these individuals. If these individuals decide to accept the offer of active membership, they would then assume the duties and responsibilities of club membership the same as any other active member.

## C. Training classes for flyball and agility.

The group discussed situations which are occurring for which there are no current procedures (including offering and accepting fees for structured classes in a special activity without notice to or approval of the Training Committee).

The Membership Committee recommends that the Training Committee remind the club membership that curriculum and fees are set and approved by the Training Committee. Therefore, the offering of any classes, especially to the general public for which a training fee is charged, should be presented to the Training Committee for approval.

There was some discussion concerning disbursements when a question was asked about what the \$1,000 + was spent for during the past month.
